



What we are learning:

The "Chew on This" series will bring Apologetics to the Zone! As our entire congregation dives into big questions about the Bible, we will bring a few questions a week that kids wonder about. The goal of this series is to encourage kids to keep asking questions because God never grows tired of providing the answers!

Questions covered each week:

Week 1-

1. Where exactly did the Bible come from?

Answer: The Bible was written by over 35 authors, guided by the Holy Spirit, over hundreds of years.

2. Are the stories in the Bible real?

Answer: Yes. While amazing and sometimes even mind-blowing, they aren't just made up. They actually happened in history.

3. What if we can't totally prove the Bible is real?

Answer: Hebrews 11:1 tells us that **faith** is how we believe in things we cannot see.

Week 2-

1. Is it okay for Christians to believe in science?

Answer: Yes! There is actually a lot of science in the Bible, especially in books like Job.

2. How can God be everywhere at once?

Answer: According to Jeremiah 23:24, God IS everywhere on Earth and in Heaven.

3. Who created God?

Answer: Colossians 1:17 tells us that God existed before anything else and holds all of creation together.

Week 3-

1. What happens after we die?

Answer: According to the Bible, we have the ability to follow Jesus into eternal life. This means if we choose to believe in Jesus, we don't have to be afraid of death.

2. Where is heaven?

Answer: Heaven is simply wherever God is, and according to Revelation 21:3 His plan is to bring heaven to us.

3. What will I do in Heaven?

Answer: We will finally be able to see our Heavenly Father and according to 1 Corinthians 2:9, everything else will be better than we could ever imagine.

Week 4-

1. Is God mad?

Answer: Exodus 34:6 tells us that God is slow to anger. We see throughout the Bible that God does get angry when we do things to hurt each other or when we separate ourselves from Him.

2. If God is good, why does He let bad stuff happen?

Answer: As humans, we will never understand all of God's plans. However, Romans 8:28 tells us that His plans will always be for our good!

3. How do I get to know God?

Answer: Romans 10:17 tells us that faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.
