The Bible Breakdown - S.O.A.R.

You are my refuge and my shield; I have put my hope in your Word. Psalm 119:114

Why the Word?

Before the world began, the Word was there. The Word was with God, and the Word was God. ²He was there with God in the beginning. ³Everything was made through him, and nothing was made without him. ⁴In him there was life, and that life was a light for the people of the world. ⁵The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not defeated it. John 1:1-5 ERV

The Word = Christ, Him = The Word.

How does John 1:1-5 make you feel about the Bible?

Key Verses

But he answered, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every WORD that comes from the mouth of God.'" Matthew 4:4 (see Deuteronomy 8:3, Luke 4:4, John 4:34)

Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the WORD of God.

Ephesians 6:17 (see Hebrews 4:12, Hosea 6:5-6, 2 Corinthians 6:7)

For you have been born again, but not to a life that will quickly end. Your new life will last forever because it comes from the eternal, living WORD of God. (see James 1:18, John 1:13)

How to S.O.A.R.

S.O.A.R is an acronym to help you dig deeper into God's Word. Below are the meanings of each letter. Before you begin, pray and ask God for His guidance as you read through his Word.

S-Scripture

In this section, fill in which verse or passage grabbed your attention.

O-Observation

What does God seem to be revealing through the scripture? Answer who, what, why, where, and how questions. If you would like to go deeper look up the Hebrew or Greek meaning and cross-reference different scriptures with a similar topic. Use a Study Bible or explore different commentaries.

A-Application

How do you apply this scripture to your life? How can you live differently in light of what God has spoken to you?

R-Reflection (Prayer)

Take a moment to be still and let God show you how to walk out this scripture. Write a prayer asking God for wisdom and guidance.
