## GROUP FLOW

1. Play ZTV (10 min.)
2. Discussion Time (15 min.)
3. Closing (2-3 min.)

### 1. Play ZTV

A. Watch This Weekend's ZTV as a family: Go to GFCZone.TV

### 2. Discussion Time

1. ICEBREAKER GAME: Stand up for (A) or Sit Down for (B)  
Optional: Whoever gets the most right wins a prize (Example prizes: choose their own dessert, joy of winning, etc.)
  1. **When Ezekiel spoke God's words** (A) The bones disappeared (B) The bones started rattling (Correct)
  2. **Where is the Lord's Prayer found?**  
(A) Matthew 6:9-13 (Correct) (B) Mark 6:9-13
  3. **The Lord's Prayer starts with**  
(A) Our Father (Correct) (B) Your Father
1. **Repetition Activity: Let's Stand up! When I:**
  - a. **Hold out my arms:** we say "Our Father."
  - b. **Point both arms up,** we say, "Who is in heaven."
  - c. **Hold my hands over my heart,** we say "May your name be kept holy."
  - d. **Fly like an airplane,** we say "Your Kingdom Come"
  - e. **Point one arm up,** we say "Your Will be done."
  - f. **Sit down really fast,** we say "On earth as it is in heaven." Do this as many times as you want in a **3 minute max.** time span. **Mix it up:** Do it out of order, as a robot, in different voices, **pick different kids** to call it.
2. **Let's read this verse out loud again together!** Circle the word "Hallowed" and write Holy next to it from the extra paper as you read, and explain that they mean the same thing.
3. (Circle "Kingdom") **What do you think of when you see the word Kingdom?** Open ended, let them share.
4. **When I think of God's Kingdom, I think of God's uninterrupted power (circle "will") that brings life and hope. How did Ezekiel bring God's will to the dead?** He listened to God's instruction and spoke God's word over the bones. He invited what he couldn't see (God's kingdom) into the situation before him.
5. **How can you talk to God differently this week after learning this part of the Lord's Prayer?** We can keep learning God's Word, like the Lord's prayer, to speak God's will over our lives.

### 3. Closing

A. **Prayer: Take Prayer Requests.** Ask your child to pray out loud with your family: **Our father, may your Kingdom come, may your will be done. We invite you to come and work in every situation of our lives.**

B. **Big Idea:** Stand up, cue the Big Idea (ie. 1, 2, 3) Always Stop and Pray!
